



FORMER KANSAS RESIDENT REFUND OF MOTOR VEHICLE TAXES

Kansas statute allows for a refund of the unused portion of the motor vehicle taxes if the resident of Kansas has established residence in another state.

Instructions: All of the following items shall be submitted to the County Treasurer’s Office in the County in which the motor vehicle was registered:

1. Current Kansas owner’s registration receipt OR \$1.00 check payable to Department of Motor Vehicles in order to process a duplicate.
2. A copy of all registered owner’s current new state driver’s license.
3. A copy of the applicant’s current new state registration.
4. The Kansas license plate (both plates if personalized), OR if plate is lost/stolen, a police report and a three dollar (\$3.00) check made payable to the Department of Motor Vehicles to replace and process.

5. List all registered owner’s Social Security Numbers (or Federal ID number if applicable). If registered “and” all signatures required.
